

GDAA partnership propositions

Leadership

- 2 members of DA Steering committee to join GDAA governing council
- Once per year joint Steering Group / Governors conference calls
- Access to the GDAA Advisory Council as sounding board
- Support in developing an aggregator reporting process – a number of organizations collaborate and report through one key representative organization on the performance of the group

GDAA partnership propositions

Implementation

- Pilots. GDAA may support the implementation of a small number of key sustainability program pilots, working with the pilots to reach implementation and importantly capture the experiences and monitor progress against milestones and targets.
- Webinars and conference calls. Facilitate sharing of experiences between Dairy Asia and DSF members
- Coordination and support for an annual one-day Dairy Asia Sustainability Workshop.

GDAA partnership propositions

Implementation

- Dairy Asia implementation awards. Annual awards process that requires Dairy Asia members to profile and share their sustainability initiatives with the possibility of having it recognized as best practice
- Support with a Dairy Asia Sustainability annual report profiling key implementation success stories.
